Fact Sheet: Transportation

Prices listed below are one way.

Transportation from Airport and Train Station

The closest airport to the college is La Guardia, in New York City, Newark Airport in New Jersey is also an option. It may cost more for rides from JFK Airport in New York to the college.

Taxicabs, Uber, Lyft, and Juno from Airports

- Estimated average cost of cab from La Guardia Airport to college\$50-\$75
- Estimated average cost of cab from Newark Airport to college\$70
- Estimated average cost of Lyft, Uber, or Juno from La Guardia Airport to college\$38-\$68
- Estimated average cost of Lyft or Uber ride from Newark Airport to college\$60-\$65

Light Rail and Subway Service

1. Board the #1 subway in New York City. (View “New York Subway Information” for a listing of stations.)

- From La Guardia Airport to Manhattan College:
 - Take the Q70 airport connector, then transfer to the E or R subway.
 - Transfer to the #1 Subway northbound at the Times Square (42nd Street & Broadway) Station.
- From Newark Airport to Manhattan College:
 - Take New Jersey Transit, either the North Jersey Coast (blue) or the Northeast Corridor (red).
 - Transfer to the #1 Subway northbound at New York Penn Station.
- From New York Penn Station (reached by New York subways and New Jersey Transit):
 - Take the #1 Subway north to Van Cortlandt Park.

2. Exit the #1 Subway and walk to Manhattan College.

- Exit at the Van Cortlandt Park stop. Climb about 50 steps, then walk to the college.
- Exit at the 231st Street stop. Take the elevator to street level, cross the street (Broadway) Take the northbound bus to 242nd Street., then walk to the college
 - Take a taxi or shared ride to the college (refer to addresses below.).

3. Walk to the college from the 242nd Street Train or Bus Stop.

- Manhattan College will be about one block to the west. Walking directions to Horan Hall (the dormitory) and Kelly Commons (meeting rooms) will be available at a later date. Check ClutterersAnonymous.org for updates.

Driving Directions to Manhattan College

From the South

- Take I-95 North and NY-9A North/State Highway 9A North/Henry Hudson Parkway to Henry Hudson Parkway East in Bronx, New York.
- Take Exit 20 from NY-9A North/State Highway 9A North/Henry Hudson Parkway
- Follow Henry Hudson Parkway east to Manhattan College Parkway.

From Newark Airport

- Get on I-78 Express East/Phillipsburg–Newark Expressway from Newark International Airport.
- Take I-95 North and NY-9A North/State Hwy 9A North/Henry Hudson Parkway to Henry Hudson Parkway East in Bronx, New York.
- Take Exit 20 from NY-9A North/State Highway 9A North/Henry Hudson Parkway
- Follow Henry Hudson Parkway East to Manhattan College Parkway,



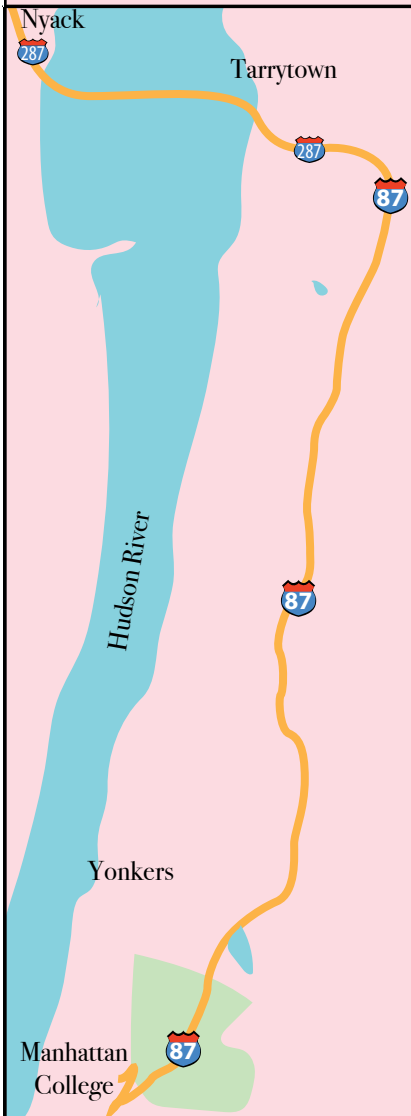
From La Guardia Airport

- Get on Grand Central Parkway from LaGuardia Access Road.
- Take I-278 East.
- Take I-87 North.
- Exit Van Cortlandt Park South in Bronx (Exit 11).
- Go north on Broadway.
- Turn left on 242nd Street to Manhattan College Parkway.

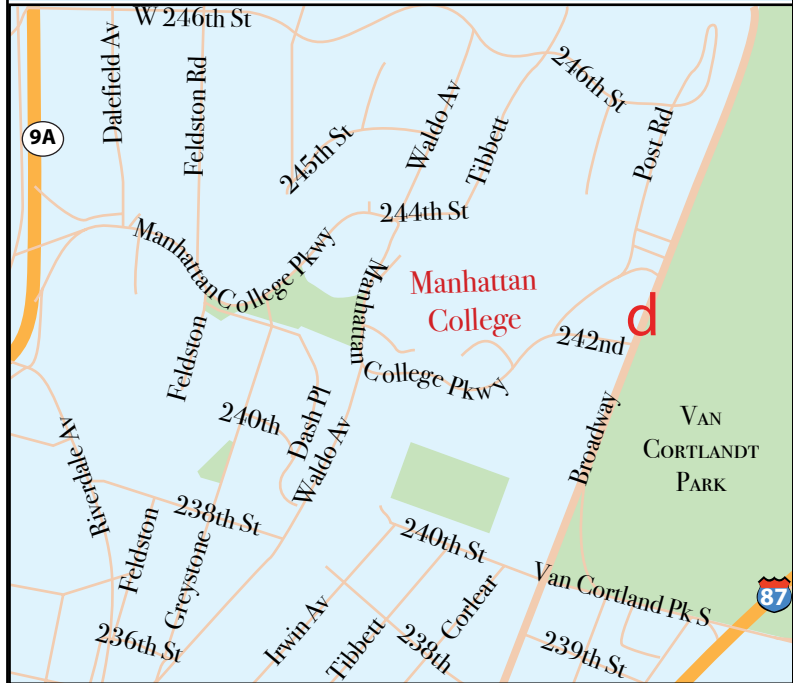


From the North

- Take I-287 and/or I-87 South to Van Cortlandt Park South in Bronx, New York. Take Exit 11 from I-87 South.
- Take Broadway north to Manhattan College Parkway.
